TRANSFER OF CREDIT POLICIES AND ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS

Transfer of Credit Policies

The College will consider accepting college credits from another college or university that the student previously attended. Students should provide an official transcript from the previous college or university to an Admissions Representative. The Office of the Vice President of Academic Affairs will evaluate the official transcript to determine if advanced standing may be granted for comparable courses.

Additionally, the College will consider providing advanced standing for life-long learning experience. Students should petition the Office of the Vice President of Academic Affairs to receive college credits for life-long learning.

Articulation Agreements

The College has a number of articulation agreements with colleges and universities. These agreements enable graduates to transfer to colleges and universities to complete Bachelor degree programs.

Articulation agreements as of November 19, 2024, include:
